

PAVO SCOREKEEPER/LINE JUDGE MEMBER REGISTRATION

Certification is for a one-year period, ending each June 1st. To retain certification, a PAVO scorekeeper/line judge must submit this form, \$15 annual dues, and the current-year examination answer sheet. The examination sheet must be an original (no copies), corrected to 100%, and signed by a PAVO-approved instructor. In addition, a PAVO scorekeeper/line judge must attend a clinic each year that is conducted by a PAVO-approved instructor. Every other year, three written recommendations are also required. The \$15 in annual dues is applicable for line judge certification, scorekeeper certification, or both certifications. PAVO members who join through a local PAVO board do not have to submit the additional \$15 dues.
